At its meeting in Sinaia on 26/03/2019, the Interreg Europe monitoring committee decided on which applications to approve in the fourth call for proposals.

We are pleased to inform you that the application **PGI05992 FOUNDATION** has been **approved under conditions** by the monitoring committee. The conditions are available in the programme's online monitoring system, iOLF (www.iolf.eu) under 'Project History' / 'Conditions'. All conditions must be fulfilled before a final approval for funding can be given. All relevant documents should be sent to the joint secretariat as soon as possible, and by **31/05/2019** at the latest.

The monitoring committee's decision will be legally effected through the subsidy contract. The contract will be sent to you, as lead partner, as soon as the conditions are fulfilled. Expenditure is eligible for Interreg Europe funding from the date of the monitoring committee's decision, i.e. 26/03/2019.

The official start date for the project is 01/08/2019 but the implementation of the planned activities should start as soon as possible to ensure a proper closing of phase 1 (see section 6.4.1 of the programme manual – version 7 decided by the Monitoring Committee on 26 and 27/03/2019).

We will be in touch soon to propose you a date for an online meeting with the joint secretariat to provide more details regarding the fulfilment of conditions.
