on the other hand,

Article 1: Object

The present agreement has for object to determine and organize the exchanges of partnership between Photoworks and the Municipality.

Article 2: Duty of the Municipality

The Municipality offers a representative of Photoworks the possibility to be a member of the jury for the selection of the 7 artists, chosen from a public call for application, for the exhibition Giovane Fotografia Italiana, 7th edition, promoted by the Municipality of Reggio Emilia in collaboration with GAI – Associazione per il circuito dei giovani artisti italiani, Fetart – Circulation(s). Festival de la jeune photographie européenne; Festival Panoràmic – Granollers, Barcelona; Fondazione Palazzo Magnani, in the context of the Fotografia Europea Festival 2020 in Reggio Emilia.

The Municipality commits to hosting a representative of Photowork/Brighton Photo Biennial in Reggio Emilia during the opening days of the festival (April 17th-19th 2020) by covering travel, board and lodging expenses.

The Municipality commits to host selected works from the Photoworks programme, agreed by both parties, as a slideshow in the edition 2020 of Giovane Fotografia Italiana - Fotografia Europea to be held in Reggio Emilia from April 17th to May 24th.

The Municipality commits to put an information board on the exhibition place about the festival.

The Photoworks logo will be on the following communication media supports of the festival:

- the press kit
- the website

The Municipality commits to provide information via its social media on selected activities and events in the Photoworks programme for 2020, agreed by both parties, such as calls for application and openings.

Article 3: Duty of Photoworks

Photoworks commits to hosting Giovane Fotografia Italiana either as a slideshow within an exhibition and/or by organizing a talk/presentation, at a venue/venues in the UK agreed by both parties or within the Brighton Photo Biennial. If a talk or event is organized, Photoworks commits to hosting a representative of Giovane Fotografia Italiana by covering travel, board and lodging expenses. Photoworks commits to positioning interpretation in the exhibition venue with information about the project and the artists.

The logos of the Giovane Fotografia Italiana promoters will be present as festival partner on the following communication media supports:

- the press kit
- the website

Photoworks commits to provide information via its social media on the main activities and events of Giovane Fotografia Italiana – Fotografia Europea 2020, such as calls for application and openings.
