represented by Valentina Galloni, Director of the Cultural Services, hereinafter referred as «the Municipality»
on the other hand,

Article 1: Object

The present agreement has for object to determine and organize the exchanges of partnership between Photoworks and the Municipality.

Article 2: Duty of the Municipality

The Municipality offers a representative of Photoworks the possibility to be a member of the jury for the selection of the 7 artists, chosen from a public call for application, for the exhibition Giovane Fotografia Italiana, 11th edition, promoted by the Municipality of Reggio Emilia in collaboration with GAI - Associazione per il circuito dei giovani artisti italiani and Fotografia Europea festival 2024.

The Municipality commits to hosting a representative of Photowork Festival in Reggio Emilia during the opening days of the festival (April 26th- 28th 2024) by covering travel, board and lodging expenses.

The Municipality commits to hosting selected works from the Photoworks programme, agreed by both parties, as a slideshow in the edition 2024 of Giovane Fotografia Italiana to be held in Reggio Emilia from April 26th to June 9th.

The Municipality commits to put an information board on the exhibition place about the Photoworks programme.

The Photoworks logo will be on the following communication media supports of the festival:

The Municipality commits to providing information via its social media on selected activities and events in the Photoworks programme for 2024, agreed by both parties, such as calls for application and openings.

The Municipality commits to finding the resources to fund two scholarships to cover travel expenses for two photographers shortlisted for the Giovane Fotografia Italiana | Premio Luigi Ghirri Award 2024 by supporting them in participating in an artist residency in the Dalby Forest, Yorkshire, (north England).

Article 3: Duty of Photoworks

Photoworks commits to hosting Giovane Fotografia Italiana either as a slideshow within an exhibition and/or by organizing a talk/presentation, at a venue/venues in the UK agreed by both parties. If a talk or event is organized, Photoworks commits to hosting a representative of Giovane Fotografia Italiana by covering travel, board and lodging expenses.

Photoworks commits to positioning interpretation in the exhibition venue with information about the project and the artists.

Photoworks commits to offering a one-week artist residency in Dalby Forest, Yorkshire (north England), to two photographers with an ecological interest and shortlisted for the Giovane Fotografia Italiana | Luigi Ghirri Award 2024.

The logos of the Giovane Fotografia Italiana promoters will be present as festival partner on the following communication media supports:

Photoworks commits to providing information via its social media on the main activities and events of Giovane Fotografia Italiana 2024, such as calls for applications and openings.
